Congratulations! I am happy to inform you that your application for a legislative grant will be funded in the 2008-09 state budget. I have been successful in obtaining funding for the Homework Club in the amount of \$4,000.

Within the next several months, you will be contacted by the state agency overseeing your particular grant with a contract for you to review, sign and return to them. The agency will then review it and sign off on it. This formal contract is necessary before there can be a transfer of the appropriated funds. It will also be reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and the Attorney General's office before a check is cut by the Division of the Budget. This process usually takes several months.
